## GFWC KANSAS STATE MUSIC AUDITIONS RULES AND GUIDELINES

- 1. CATEGORIES: Piano, Strings, Girl's Voice, Boy's voice, Woodwinds/Brass, Melodic Percussion/Percussion which includes Harp, Marimba, Xylophone, Acoustic Classical Guitar, and Drums.
- 2. Students are to be sponsored by GFWC Kansas Clubs. The entry fee is \$10.00 per entry. Fees may be paid by the sponsoring club, student, parent, or teacher.
- 3. The GFWC Club Music Chairperson and/or Club President are responsible for student entry forms accompanied with the entry fee sent to State Music chairperson two weeks prior to the State Music Auditions.
- 4. Students are to be 14 years of age through 18 years of age as of March 1 or a senior in high school.
- 5. It is preferred to have music memorized and an extra ten (10) points will be given in scoring on each memorized selection. A copy of the music with numbered measures must be available for the use of the judge. Copyright rules must be observed.
- 6. Students are to perform two (2) solos of contrasting styles or different composers. Piano participants may not perform a piano concerto which would require an orchestra or second piano for performance. All students are discouraged from choosing any work in which the solo part is diminished by the performance of the accompaniment.
- 7. Performance must be kept within ten (10) minutes, movements may be shortened or cut in accordance with the judge's instruction.
- 8. Students cannot participate in a given category if they have previously been awarded a scholarship in that category.
- 9. NO tape or CD accompaniment will be allowed.
- 10. Scholarships will be awarded at the State Audition dependent upon available funds.
